Gradient on other types of isoline maps can be interpreted similarly. A high pressure gradient on an isobar map indicates a high pressure gradient force and strong winds, while a low pressure gradient suggests light winds. Profile refers to a cross-section, or horizontal view, of some part of the isoline map. For example, if I walked from A to B on the map, my path would look like the drawing at the bottom.
