Physician Practice E/M Guidelines

The three key components when selecting the appropriate level of E/M services provided are history, examination, and medical decision making. Visits that consist predominately of counseling and/or coordination of care are an exception to this rule.

BASICS of E/M CODING

HPI scoring: 6 elements = Extended Patient and daughter report increasing distress related to finding that he has repeatedly lost small objects (e.g., keys, bills, items of clothing) over the past 2-3 months Patient notices intermittent, mild (severity)forgetfulness (quality)of people's names and what he is about to say in a conversation.

E/M Coding Fact and Fiction

The CCS is a timed exam. Candidates have four hours to complete the exam. The total number of questions on the exam range between 115 and 140 total items. The exam consists of two sections, a Multiple-Choice Section and a Medical Scenario Section (inpatient, outpatient, and emergency department). The exam is given in a computer-based format.

Certified Coding Specialist (CCS) | AHIMA

The CPC exam is comprised of 150 multiple-choice questions. The test takes five hours and 40 minutes to complete, making it fairly rigorous. There are two breaks in the middle of the test. The CPC exam costs \$300 to take, but only \$260 if the test-taker is a member of the AAPC (annual dues are \$125 for individuals and \$70 for students).

The CPCT program is for specimen collector supervisors and trainers and requires training at a CPCT course. The CPC program is for individual collectors working at sites or companies. Both the CPC and CPCT collector certification designations require passage of an annual exam. The Accredited Collection Facility (ACF) program is for companies who have all their collectors certified.
